Road Safety

A member of the public has expressed concern over a couple of children cycling on the wrong side of the road and on a blind bend on Churchfoot Lane. Please remind your child/ren about cycling safely.

We have bikeability in school next week for children in Eagles. Please ensure your child's bike is in school on Monday and in a road worthy condition. A suitable helmet is also required, as well as a permission slip in order to participate. This is a fantastic opportunity to teach children about road safety. All details are on School Spider.

We have increasing comments regarding some unsafe driving and parking during arrival and dismissal. Please help us to keep our family community safe, park suitably at the beginning and end of the day, do not park on the zig zag lines near the main gate and slow down when children are travelling to and from school.

Concerns have also been raised regarding children being left in the car alone whilst dropping siblings off. You are encouraged to drop any nursery child off at their entrance and then make your way around to the main gate to drop off any older siblings.

We have a further meeting regarding our car park proposal next week. We are aware this will take some time but are pursuing the matter in order to encourage further safety around our school grounds.

Please also be mindful of our local residents and do not obstruct their drive/gateways.

We do all that we can to keep our children and their families safe, such as, opening gates early to prevent families waiting on the roadside near a bend. Please do not gather in this area as it does prevent clear sightings for drivers coming around the bend and staff supervising the children. Your safety is also very important to us.
