Hello from all of us at Hazelbury Bryan Primary School and Pre-School.

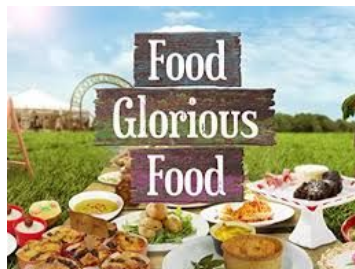

EYFS - 2 - 3 hours per day

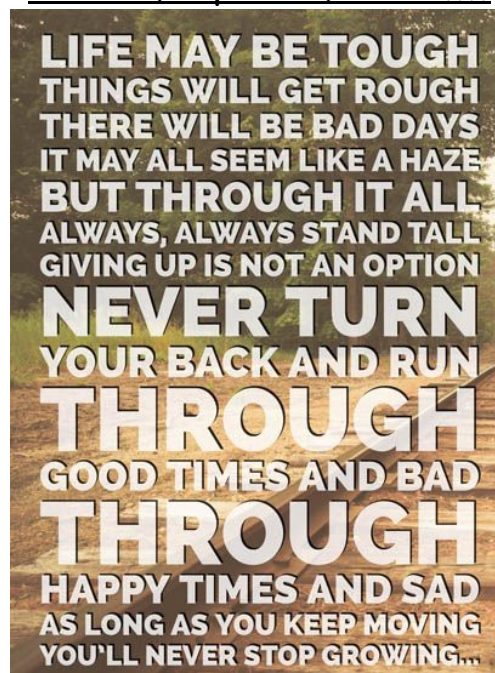
KS1 - 3 hours per day
