Hello from all of us at Hazelbury Bryan Primary School and Pre-School.

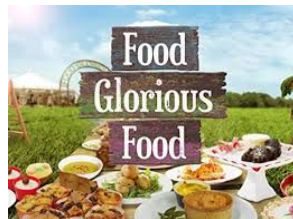


We miss seeing you all every day and look forward to seeing you soon!

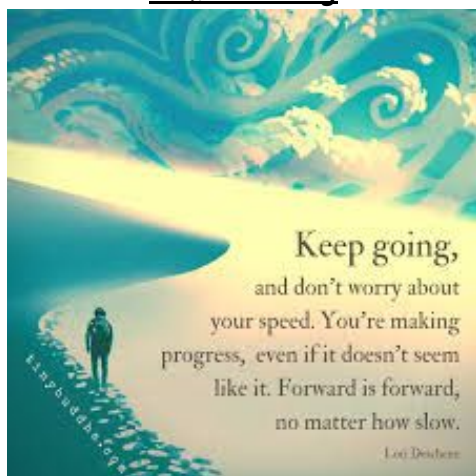
Weekly Reading Challenge
