Dinners

Hot dinners are back. Place your orders online with Local Food Links, these need to be done 7 days in advance.

If you have not ordered already, you will need to provide a packed lunch. Packed lunches must be in a disposable bag and all necessary cutlery, i.e. spoon for yoghurts, provided.

 Reading book on days specified by your class teacher due to quarantine reasons.

Forest School

EYFS and Eagles are lucky enough to have Forest School every Monday until the Easter holidays. Come to school in warm, sensible clothing. Wellies are needed and will be left outside until your session. Barn Owls and Owls should already have wellies in school.

Our School Day

Parents to drop children off at the gate or Foundation Base as follows:

Barn Owls arrive via the driveway and around to your classroom at 9am

Owls arrive via the driveway and around to your classroom at 8.50am

Kestrels arrive at the main gate at 8.50am

Hawks arrive at the main gate at 8.40am

Eagles arrive at the main gate at 8.30am

Collect your child/children from the Foundation Base or main gates as follows:

Barn Owls: 3pm from Barn Owls classroom
Owls: 3.10pm from Owls classroom
Kestrels: 3.20pm from playground
Hawks: 3.10pm from playground
Eagles: 3pm from playground

Please adhere to times stated and leave the premise immediately to prevent congestion.

Hygiene gel will be provided at the gate and temperatures will be checked.
