Masks

All children receive weekly homework on Google Classroom. This usually entails a piece of maths, a piece of english and spellings to learn for that week. This must be completed on Google Classroom and submitted by the deadline set. As well as encouraging discipline and responsibility, homework consolidates learning and reinforces important messages in order to support the children's learning. All teachers have reminded the children of how to access and complete homework this week. We will be offering support with homework once a week at lunchtime if the children cannot access it at home. After this time they will miss part of their golden time on a Friday to catch up. I hope you will support us with home learning.
