If anyone would be willing to donate a box of tissues to your child's class that would be very much appreciated.

Could you be eligible for Healthy Start Vitamins?

If you or a friend or family member is more than 10 weeks pregnant or has a child under 4 years, then they may be entitled to help to buy healthy food and milk, and get free Healthy Start vitamins. Extra vitamins can help if you're pregnant or breastfeeding.

Recent research shows that many families are missing out on claiming extra support to pay for healthy food and vitamins.

The NHS Healthy Start scheme aims to help those who are on a low income or qualifying benefit and are eligible, to buy food and milk through a prepaid card this includes:

- Plain liquid cow's milk
- Fresh, frozen, and tinned fruit and vegetables
- Fresh, frozen and tinned pulses
- Infant formula milk based on cow's milk
- Healthy Start vitamins
- Vitamin drops for babies and young children

Those eligible can receive top ups of £4.25 or £8.50 a week depending on the age of their child.
