We thoroughly enjoyed celebrating Maths and this year's theme of 'Maths is Everywhere' on Thursday this week. The children supported one another to complete a variety of fun Maths activities in the hall that raised awareness of Maths, demonstrated how fun Maths can be and most importantly taught the children how Maths is all around us. <p style="text-align: center;">Music Lessons</p> <p>We are very fortunate to have 3 excellent music teachers coming into school; Mr Dave Gassmann who currently teaches the flute, Mr Tom Clements teaching the guitar and the piano is taught by Kingsley McGregor. From September Dorset Music Service are changing the way they offer tuition. In future it will be a private arrangement between you and the instructor.</p> <p>Mr Gassmann is able to offer the following: Brass - Trumpet/Coronet & Trombone Woodwind - Recorder, Flute, Clarinet & Alto Sax Lessons will be for Years 2-6 (Years 5 and 6 only for saxophone due to the weight of the instrument). The individual cost will be 20 minutes - £10, 30 minutes - £15. If your child has shared lessons in groups of 2 - 4 the cost of the 30 minute lesson will be divided by the number of children. Instruments can still be hired through the Dorset Music Service costing around £60 per year. If you would like your child to learn an instrument in September please let the office know. If they are currently learning the flute or guitar please let the school office know if they would like to continue.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Late Booking Fee</p> <p>As you know we ask that you book breakfast and after school club by the Friday preceding your requirements in order that we have sufficient staff and provisions. There are an increasing number of parents who are booking at the last minute which is difficult to manage.</p> <p>From Monday 5 June we are re-introducing the administration fee of £4.00 per day for those bookings which are not made in advance.</p> <p>This is to help cover the additional paperwork involved in adjustments to registers, invoicing, payment recovery, staffing and food preparation.</p> <p>We appreciate there are unforeseen circumstances that can crop up from time to time but we feel that because we have been accommodating in adding to registers at the last minute there are occasions when parents have not planned in advance.</p>
