

English Class text- Poems to perform

We will listen to poems from this collection, expressing interest and preferences whilst making choices for our own class anthologies on a preferred theme. The tuneful nature and predictable pattern of the poems will engage the children in recital and expressive performance. We will explore vivid imagery which will inspire creative responses and extend interest in the meaning of words. The poetry offers inspiration to young budding poets and will serve as a model for the development of their own poetry writing.

Science- Living things and their habitats

We will learn about a variety of habitats and the plants and animals that live there. We will learn to tell the difference between things that are living, dead and things that have never been alive. We will make observations of a local habitat and the creatures that live there.

Computing- Creating media, digital photography

We will learn to recognise that different devices can be used to capture photographs and will gain experience capturing, editing, and improving photos. Finally, we will use this knowledge to recognise that images they see may not be real.

PE- Gymnastics

We will learn to travel safely in different ways, at different speeds and levels. We will learn to jump safely on the ground and onto and from equipment. We will jump and roll into different shapes, and put contrasting movements together to make sequences that they remember, repeat and perform.

Music-

The children will learn that playing together is a very important part of learning music. There are many ensembles, bands and groups you can play in. One of these groups is an orchestra.

RE- Jesus as a gift from God

We will learn about how to solve a problem by showing love. We will remember the Christmas story and start to understand why Christians believe Jesus was a gift from God.

Maths- Addition and subtraction

Y1- We will learn to understand, read and write the += symbols. We will learn numbers bonds to 10/20 and add/subtract 1 or 2 digit numbers to 20.

Y2- We will recall and use addition and subtraction facts to 20. We will derive facts to 100 and will add and subtract numbers 1 or 2 digit numbers.

Shape

Y1- We will identify and name 2D/3D shapes, describe them and find them in our environment.

Y2- We will identify and name 2D/3D shapes. They will describe the properties of 2D shapes, including the number of sides and line symmetry in a vertical line.

History- Remember, remember the 5th November

We will about the past by finding out about Guy Fawkes and other significant individuals involved in the plot, such as Robert Catesby and Thomas Percy. They will deepen their understanding of the events of the Gunpowder Plot through several activities.

DT-Seasonal soups!

We will learn about peeling, cutting safely and applying these skills when preparing soup. They will learn about healthy eating and where their food comes from. They will learn about ingredients that can be combined to make interesting and tasty soups.

PSHE/RSE-Be my best

The children will learn about why certain foods are healthy and why it's important to eat at least five portions of vegetables/fruit a day. They will also learn different problem solving techniques when they find something difficult.
