We will also be showcasing our Samba workshop and may even have time to Stormbreak with you.

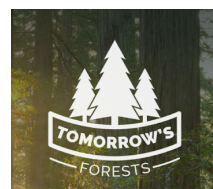

This annual celebration of authors, illustrators, books and the joy of reading is one of the many highlights of our year. We will be asking children to come to school dressed as a character from their favourite book. Bonus awards to homemade costumes! Your child should bring their favourite book with them if this is possible. We will also be holding a 'Read a Rainbow' competition, where the children will be asked to read a book, or selection of books at home, containing anything of each colour of the rainbow, e.g. Red - Little Red Riding Hood or a ladybird or even a red front cover. Children that complete this challenge will be put into a prize draw and prizes will be drawn. The children will also share their favourite book which they have brought in, with other children across the school who are in their houses.

Tomorrow's Forest

A huge thank you to Liz and Nick, from Tomorrow's Forest. On Wednesday, Liz worked with each class throughout the day giving them a Wonderful Winter Forest experience through many engaging activities. She introduced our EYFS children to the forest in winter through sensory experiences. Kestrels learned about forests in winter, focusing on evergreen trees and how nature adapts to the colder months. Hawks developed their understanding of how the forest and its inhabitants adapt to winter conditions. Eagles explored how trees and wildlife survive and adapt to winter.
