COVID

We are so sorry to hear that so many of you are unwell. Please take care and get in touch if you need anything at all. Due to the number of cases in all primary schools, we do recommend daily lateral flow tests if you have been in contact (within 48 hours) of a positive case. If you, or your child, test positive you must get a PCR to confirm this. Isolation is for 10 days for positive cases and siblings do not need to isolate, following a negative test.
