Class text: Twitch by M.G. Leonard

This term we will be continuing to read the book Twitch. We will be exploring this mystery text through a variety of different activities such as role play, role on the wall, debate, conscience alley and freeze framing. These activities will help us when exploring a variety of text types which we will then plan and draft our own versions of. This term we will look at narratives, writing in role as different characters in the form of a diary entry or letter and a news report. This will develop our creative responses and our confidence with writing for a variety of purposes and audiences.

Science - Light

In this topic, we will be exploring how light travels and how we see objects. Whilst doing this, we will also look at shadows and why they have the same shape as the object that cast them. As well as this, we will continue to develop our working scientifically skills through our scientific investigations.

Computing- Programming- sensing movement.

We will begin the term exploring our e-safety focus which is credible information sources. Then we will move on to our programming which will combine 4 elements: sequence, repetition, selection and variables. We will be building programs that we will upload to a microbit.

French- Me in the World

During this topic, we will be recapping how to ask and answer questions about our name, age and where we live. We will also be locating French speaking countries and exploring some of the festivals and celebrations within those countries.

PE - Swimming

Music- Performance
