Year 3 -

Science - Animals Including Humans

We will explore what Humans and Animals need to stay healthy. We will look at Human and Animals skeletons and be able to describe them. Further to this, we will understand how muscles work.

Computing - Stop Frame Animation

We will use a range of techniques to create a stop-frame animation using tablets. Next, we will apply those skills to create a story-based animation. This unit will conclude with us adding other types of media to our animation, such as music and text.

PE - Gymnastics (Mr Betts)

We will develop flexibility, strength, technique, control and balance through gymnastics and compare their performances with previous ones and demonstrate improvement to achieve their personal best.

Music

We will be taking part in a Samba unit this half term that will be run by the Dorset Music Service.

RE - Christianity
