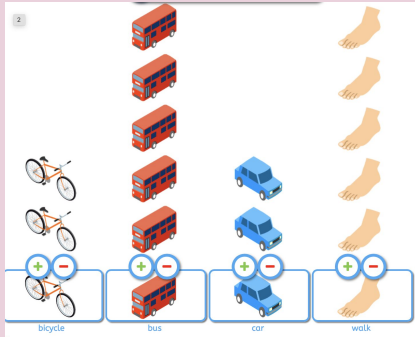


Week 1-Computing
