

Dorset Road Safe

We have recently received an email from 'Dorset Road Safe,' who work in partnership with the police, fire and councils as well as many other agencies, to improve road safety. Sadly, road traffic collisions are the leading cause of death among children and young people aged 5-29 years old. Nearly all of these deaths are preventable. The highest contributing factor for all pedestrian casualties is recorded by the police as "pedestrian failed to look properly", followed by "driver failed to look properly".

As a consequence of these devastating findings 'Dorset Road Safe,' are launching a competition for 9-16 year olds this summer. They are asking young people across Dorset to design a poster, image or animation for social media, that they can share across their social media accounts. The campaign is entitled 'see you on the road,' as the message they want young people (and drivers) to understand, is to look out for each other on the roads. There will be an exciting prize on offer for the winning entry. Please use the details provided on the message that was sent via school spider to enter. This was sent to children in Eagles and Year 4 only, due to the age bracket required for the competition.
