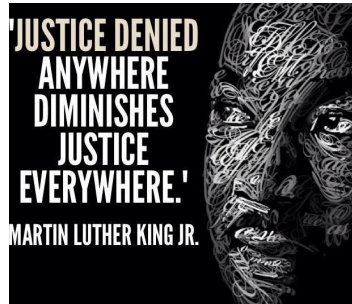




SCHOOL NEWS - 15 July 2022

Arrival and dismissal from September

From September, we will continue to open the main gates onto the playground at 8.30am. This is for children from Years 1 to 6, who wish to complete the daily mile before their morning activity.

However, the whole school will now start at 8.45am and finish at 3.15pm.

The gates will be closed at 8.45am.

Reception still go to your entrance up the driveway - your door will be open at 8.45am ready for your morning activities.

After this time, any child must sign in at the main entrance and will receive a late mark.

If anyone has a younger sibling in Owls, the older siblings will go to the Owls classroom and be dismissed with them at 3.15pm to support parents in one collection point.

We believe that these changes will have a positive impact on learning.

Stationary for September

We ask that all children in Key Stage 2 (Hawks and Eagles) bring a packet of coloured pencils and a small pencil case that will easily fit in their tray. They will be bringing home all belongings next week in order to replenish their pencils. We will provide all other stationary items. Families who receive a Pupil Premium grant, we have purchased colouring pencils for your child.

Holiday Request Forms

Holiday request Forms will not be available from September as we do not expect holidays to be taken in school time.

Did you know that of 365 days in a year, 190 days are school days and 175 are non-school days! As a school, we expect parents to use these 175 days for family time, and for activities such as shopping, appointments, day trips and family holidays. While we appreciate it's not always possible to take appointments on non-school days, we do ask that these are kept to a minimum. We will ask to see evidence of any essential appointments made. Requests for an 'Exceptional Leave of Absence' form can be obtained from the school office.

Uniform

Uniform provides a sense of belonging and encourages a positive attitude towards school life.

We will continue to come to school in PE kits on PE days, The staff and children have voted to continue with Sports Friday. Therefore, all children will come to school in their PE kits on Friday and one other day each week.

Forest School - please wear your uniform with pride but bring a change of shoes and waterproof coat. You are welcome to bring a change of clothes with you if you prefer.

Dates for next year

We have prepared dates for next year to give you advanced warning of key events. These will be shared with you in September. We will try our best to keep to these but some changes are often inevitable. Please refer to the weekly newsletters for key information, our class website pages and the online calendar.

Music Lessons

If your child, in Years 1 - 6, would like to learn the clarinet, trumpet or flute in the Autumn Term please let the school office know. There will be 10 lessons per term lasting for 20 minutes and costing £15 per lesson. If there are a few children who would like to learn the same instrument the lesson will be shared and the cost divided. Instruments can be hired through Dorset Music Service.

Hot School Lunches - Autumn Term

Please do not forget to order your child's hot school lunch via the Local Food Links website ready for September. If your child is currently in Year 2 you will not be able to order until 25 July as LFL need to remove their KS1 universal Infant Free School Meal entitlement at the end of this academic year.

Breakfast and After School Club Bookings

If you would like your child to attend Breakfast or After School Club in September please do not forget to book their place via School Spider. We will close the system, for the first week back, as normal at midday on Friday 5 September.
