Tins of beans, spaghetti hoops, macaroni cheese, rice (microwavable), pasta.

Tinned fruit, custard.

UHT Milk, dry foods, tea, coffee, juices.

Fresh food is also good, but foods that do not spoil too quickly.

Can I encourage parents to discuss this with their children in order to help them think about issues of gratitude and generosity. Gratitude is at the heart of any harvest thanksgiving, and generosity is a mindset
